We will achieve this by


- " Complying with Occupational Health & Safety Legislation and other applicable laws, regulations, statutory obligations and codes of practice.
- " Implementing and continually developing an Occupational Health and Safety Management System based on the continual improvement model outlined in *AS/NZS 4801*.
- " Identifying and reducing the risks and hazards of all types of work activities that have the potential to cause personal injury or occupational illness.
- " Regular consultation and communication on occupational health and safety issues to individuals.
- " Providing continual education, training, instruction and supervision to improve understanding of workplace hazards and safe working practices.
- " Ensuring consistent safety practices in all aspects of company activities of manufacture and installation of products.
- " Ensuring everyone complies with the appropriate standards and workplace directives issued for the protection of their own and others health and safety.
- " Undertaking regular audits of safety practices and management system.
- " Providing effective systems and resources for rehabilitation management and return to work processes.

Landmark implements and maintains an ongoing occupational health and safety program and conducts regular inspections of workplaces with the aim of preventing accidents and incidents.
